### **BUSINESS**

<u>General Business File ASAP</u> - Provides full text and indexed articles from business and management journals, trade/industry publications, and national business magazines. Also includes Company Profiles.

<u>General Business File International</u> - Access a combination of broker research reports, trade publications, newspapers, journals, and directory listings.

<u>Small Business Collection</u> - Provides insights, tips, strategies, and success stories for business schools and entrepreneurs. <u>Vocations, Careers, and Technical Education Collection</u> - Content from general career guides to industry journals.

# **COMPUTERS**

<u>Computer Database</u> - Access computer related product introductions, news and reviews in areas such as hardware, software, electronics, engineering, communications, and the application of technology.
