Tips on picking a good topic

- Know the assignment.
- Interests you.
- Information is readily available.
- Relevant but not so new there is no information out there.



Things to avoid

- Opinion based.
- Vague or too broad.
- · Controversial issues.
- Remember: It must be in the form of a question.



Term Paper Topic

- This is not a report.
- You are looking for relationships cause and effect is the most common.
- Begin with:
 - I wonder how...?
 - I wonder why...?



Term Paper Topic

- Written in form of question
- Example key words: impact, affect, increase/decrease, cause





Inverted Triangle






Main Concepts for effective research:






Developing a Research Question:

Closel What is the impact of bottled water on the environment? (What aspect of bottled water?)


How does trash pollute the environment? (Too broad: what kind of trash?
